



GDP per capita (€) and annual growth (%) in the US and the EU-28




US total unemployment and female labour force market participation




Female labour force participation (right axis)

FDI in- and out-flows in the US and EU-28




US Portfolio Investment Assets: trends and top 10 destinations in 2015

US FDI composition by sector




GINI Index (average value 2005-2013): US and EU worst and best performers



The **GINI Index*** is a measure of inequality in income distribution. 0 = absolute equality, 100 = absolute inequality.




Main trade partners (2015)

Trade in goods, exports plus imports




Top EU partners (2015)




EU exports of goods to the US (2015)




EU imports of goods from US (2015)
